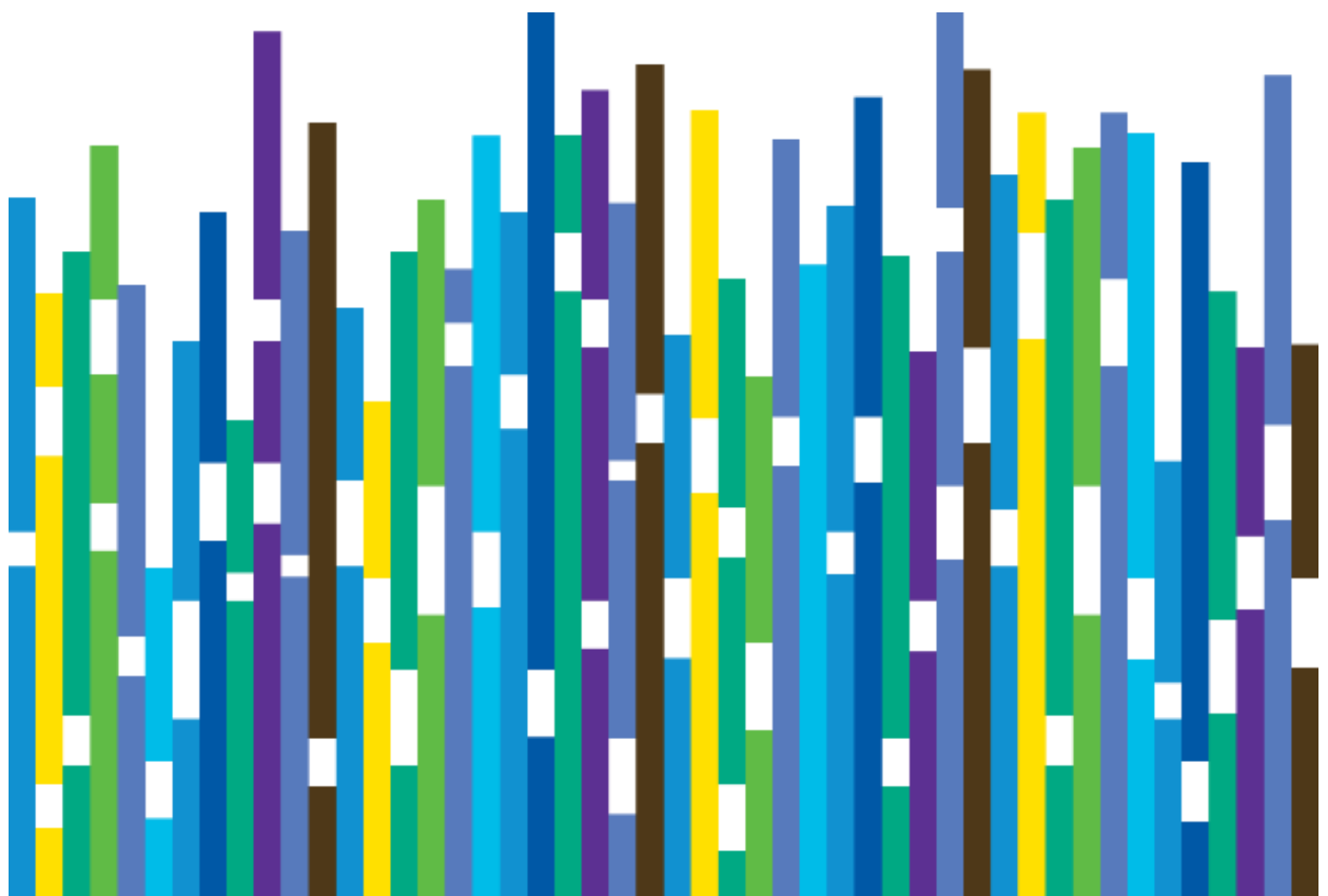


UNIVERSITY AFFILIATION PROGRAM: GUIDE TO CFA[®] PROGRAM STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PRINCIPAL CONTACTS

Best Practices for Affiliated Universities

v.FY20



Overview

As a participant in the University Affiliation Program (UAP), your university is allotted a number of scholarships that you can distribute to students as you see fit. The allotment that is granted to your university is the total number of scholarships that you can award for that fiscal year (FY). The FY21 cycle includes the final paper-based offering in December 2020, the computer-based (CBT) LI offerings throughout 2021 (February, May, August, and November), and the paper-based June 2021 Level II & III offerings. Scholarships will need to be awarded by 31 August 2021.

Students who receive UAP Scholarships pay US\$350 for exam registration, including access to the Learning Eco-System. The one-time program enrollment fee is waived. Therefore, the [three-tiered pricing](#) available on our website does NOT apply to scholarship recipients.

Students should NOT register for the exam prior to applying for a scholarship.

Important Note: access to the Scholarship Platform is granted to Principal Contacts by means of their account on CFAInstitute.org and its associated email/password, but the scholarships platform must be logged into separately from the main CFA Institute website. Important Note: there is no automatic notification sent to the PC when a scholarship application is submitted. We encourage you to monitor the scholarships platform frequently. The application is accessible through a public link. Any student at the Affiliated school can access the application and apply.

Scholarship application schedule:

December 2020 Exam

8 August 2020 – Student application submission deadline

15 August 2020 – Professor decision deadline

9 September 2020 – Final Exam Registration deadline (all scholarship recipients must complete their registration by this date, or they will forfeit their scholarship)

How are scholarship allotments determined?

Each university participating in the University Affiliation Program automatically receives a base allotment of three (3) CFA Program student scholarships per fiscal year. Additional scholarships are awarded as detailed in the table below:

Criteria	Scholarships Awarded	Limit
Base allotment	3 scholarships	Granted to all universities participating in the University Affiliation Program
Each additional degree program mapped to the CFA Program curriculum	+1 scholarship for each additional affiliated program	Not capped
Recognition of the CFA Program as an admission criteria (i.e., GMAT waiver or recognizing completion of CFA Program Level III as bachelor's degree in relevant discipline) This recognition must be stated on your university's website to qualify.	+1 scholarship	Capped at one (1)
Recognition of the CFA Program granting a course waiver (i.e., offering course credit or exemption for completion of any CFA Program exam) This recognition must be stated on your university's website to qualify.	+1 scholarship	Capped at one (1)
Offering a credit-earning stand-alone ethics course (must feature the CFA Institute Standards of Practice Handbook)	+3 scholarships	Capped at three (3)
Participation in the Professor Scholarship program	+1 scholarship	Capped at one (1)
Affiliated degree program contains a course that requires students to sit for a CFA Program exam	+1 scholarship	Capped at one (1)
Full-time* faculty who are CFA charterholders (including dean, course director, or administrator) who teach a course that is part of affiliated degree program	+3 scholarships	Not capped
Part-time** faculty who are CFA charterholders (including dean, course director, or administrator) who teaches a course that is part of affiliated degree program	+1 scholarship	Not capped

* *Full-time* is defined as teaching at least six (6) credit hours per quarter or semester (or equivalent) or an administrator teaching a minimum of three (3) credit hours per quarter or semester (or equivalent).

** *Part-time* is defined as teaching at least three (3) credit hours per quarter or semester (or equivalent) at one college or university.

Frequently Asked Questions for Principal Contacts:

What is my university's scholarship allotment?

All universities who are part of the University Affiliation Program begin with a base allotment of three (3) scholarships. Additional scholarships are allotted based on a school's responses to the Annual Review (or UAP application responses within the first fiscal year of Affiliation), increasing per the table on page 3 of this guide.

Each year, following your submission of the Annual Review, we will notify you of your scholarship allotment for the next fiscal year. If you have any questions about your allotment or would like to double check your allotment number for the current fiscal year, please email university@cfainstitute.org.

Who can award scholarships?

As the Principal Contact (PC) of the affiliated university, you and your authorized users (see below) have complete control of scholarship awards through the scholarships platform.

Can someone other than the PC review and approve scholarship applications?

Yes. As Principal Contact, you may grant access to the scholarships platform to another individual by sending an email to university@cfainstitute.org and copying in the individual(s) to whom you wish to give access. Anyone granted access to the scholarships platform will be able to review, approve, or reject a submitted application with the same authority as the PC. That is, all individuals who are granted access have the same level of control and can override each other's selections.

If you need to update access for any individual you have granted access to please email university@cfainstitute.org with that request.

How do I access the Scholarship Platform to review submitted applications?

If you are a Principal Contact with an account at CFAInstitute.org, you can access the scholarships platform using the same email/password combination at <https://scholarshipreview.cfainstitute.org/UniversityPOC/Home>.

The scholarships platform must be logged into separately from the main CFA Institute website.

If you are a Principal Contact and do not have an account on CFAInstitute.org, please follow [these instructions](#) to create an account. Then, send your CFA Institute ID number to university@cfainstitute.org to request access. Access is usually granted within 5 business days.

Are scholarships transferrable?

No. Once a student is selected, the scholarship may not be transferred to another student nor may it be applied to a future exam offering. It is important to speak with each student to let them know this so that your allotted scholarships do not go unused. Any unused scholarships will be forfeit and will not carry over to the next fiscal year.

Frequently Asked Questions continued:

Who can apply for my university's scholarships?

Any student enrolled at an affiliated university who meets the [CFA Exam registration requirements](#) is eligible and can apply for a scholarship, regardless of whether they are enrolled in the affiliated degree program, or even the appropriate department or school. However, as the “owner” of the affiliated program, the Principal Contact has sole discretion in awarding scholarships.

If you would like to require that students submit documents such as transcripts, essays, etc. in support of their application, and wish those to be uploaded to the scholarship platform, you are responsible for making applicants aware of such requirements. The scholarships platform cannot be customized for each university.

Should my students register for the exam and then apply for a scholarship?

No. Students should not register for the CFA Program prior to applying for a scholarship. In fact, registering for the exam will block their access to the scholarship application.

The early registration deadline is approaching, but scholarship decisions have not been made. Should students register in case they do not get a scholarship?

No. Students who applied but were not selected to receive a scholarship will receive the early registration price regardless of the time of their scholarship application submission. That is, if they submit a scholarship application at any time during the application window but are not selected for a scholarship, they will still receive the early registration price.

What if my students want to get a head start on their studies?

Level I & Level II

The Level I and II curriculum is integrated into the [Learning Ecosystem](#), so there is no option to purchase a digital version from CFA Institute. Students can purchase the digital curriculum from a third-party seller, but they will not receive credit for that purchase when registering for the exam.

Level III

The Level III digital curriculum can be purchased prior to registration by contacting CFA Institute via telephone and providing credit card details. The cost of this purchase will be deducted from the student's registration fee.

For All Level Applicants

A print version of the curriculum may be purchased separately. The print curriculum is not included in the exam registration fee, therefore we do not issue credits to applicants who purchase the print curriculum in advance of exam registration. Scholarship candidates are also responsible for shipping costs and any applicable import duties and taxes related to purchasing the print curriculum.

What happens when a student submits an application?

A scholarship application confirmation email will be sent to the student upon submission of their application informing them that CFA Institute has successfully received their application.

Note: there is no automatic notification sent to you, the PC, when a scholarship application is submitted. We encourage you to monitor the scholarships platform frequently.

What should your scholarship recipients be aware of?

If awarded a scholarship, **students must complete the registration process** before the final registration deadline date. The Scholarship award pricing for registration (US\$350) will automatically be reflected in their account.

Once awarded, how do students know when and how to register?

Once you have selected a student to receive a scholarship, that student will be notified via email within 2-3 weeks of selection that they received the award. Below is the text of the scholarship award email that your students will receive.

Congratulations!

You have been awarded a CFA Program Student Scholarship for the [appropriate month/year] exam! To redeem your award, enroll/register here for your exam. The reduced scholarship rate of \$350 USD which includes the e-Book has been applied to your account. The print curriculum is available separately for an additional \$150 USD + shipping/tax/duties.

Your scholarship is associated with this email address and will not work correctly if you create an account with an alternate email. If you encounter a problem with your registration, contact us. Your scholarship will expire on [appropriate registration deadline date] which is the last day to register for the [appropriate month/year] exam. You may complete your enrollment/registration by paying with your personal credit card, check, and/or wire transfer.

Please note that all CFA Program candidates must meet the Entrance Requirements for the CFA Program and adhere to the Official Scholarship Rules.

An international travel passport is required for enrollment/registration; your name as shown on CFA Institute records must be the same as your name on the passport.

It is your responsibility to completely register for the [appropriate month/day] exam prior to the final enrollment/registration deadline of [appropriate registration deadline]. As you know, only Level I of the CFA Program exam is offered in December.

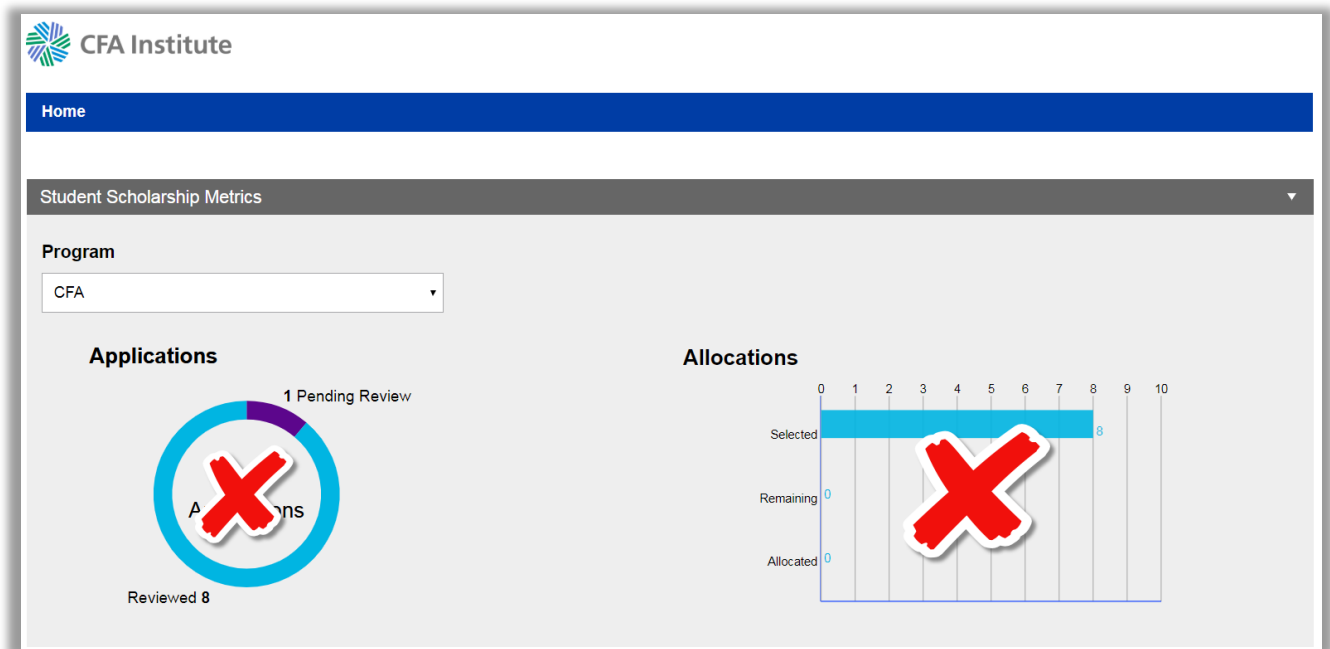

Once you have reviewed the application you can make your decision final by using the 'Application Decision' drop down menu.
